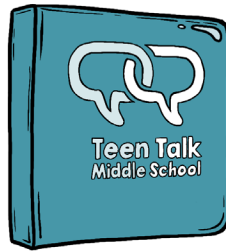

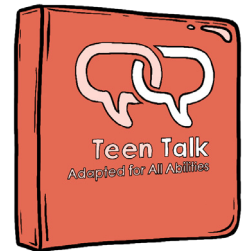

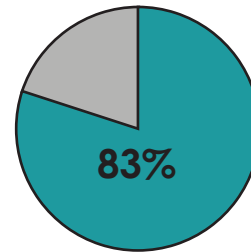
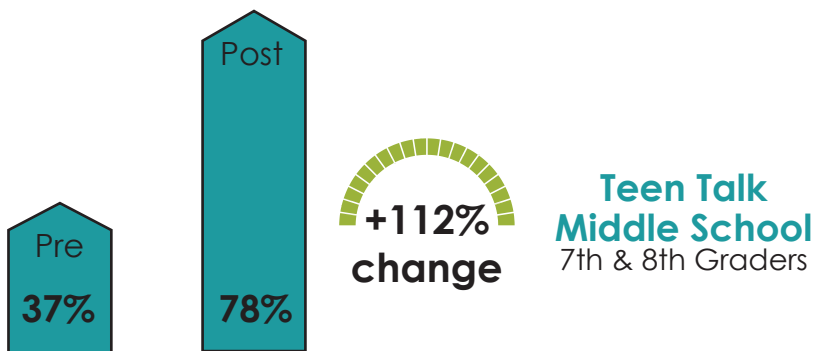
Change in Student Knowledge & Attitude by Course

Pre- & Post-Test Knowledge Change

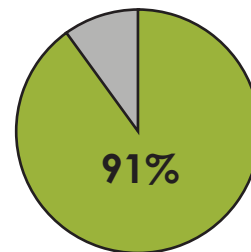
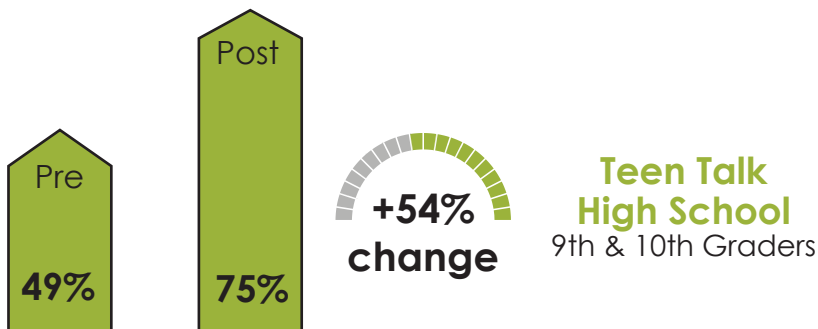
Post-Course Student Attitude



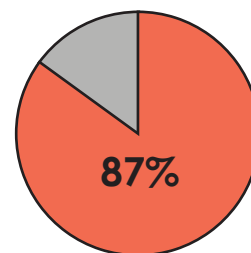
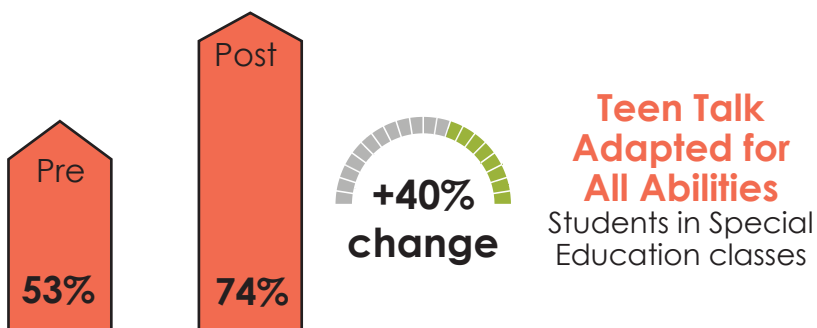
87% of 5th and 6th graders would intervene if someone made fun of another person's body or looks.



83% of 7th and 8th graders now feel more comfortable talking about sexual health with a parent or trusted adult.



91% of 9th and 10th graders agree that it will be easier for them to practice safer sex now or in the future.



87% of students in special education classes now feel more comfortable going to a clinic for sexual health services.

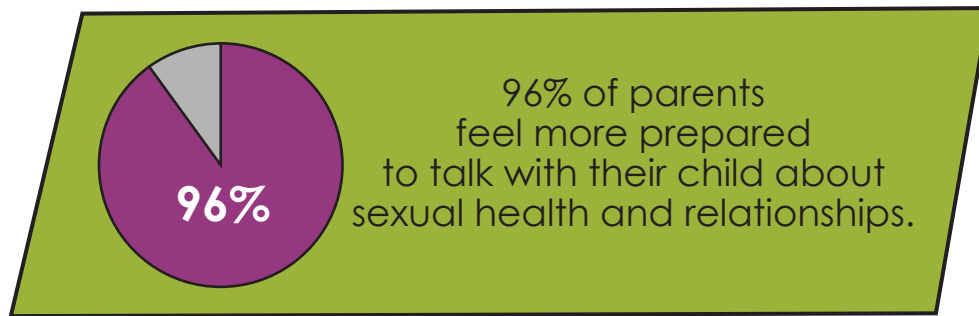
